




Did you Miss the Auction? Going, going, gone...At our Annual Fundraising Auction





Hummmmm.. To attract hummingbirds to your gardens, plant these flowers: Petunias, Asters, Marigolds, Black-eyed Susan's, Nicotiana, bee balm, Zinnias, Daises, Daylilies, Yarrow.

Easy to grow easy to maintain: African daisy, Alyssum, Calendula, Cockscomb, Larkspur, Nasturtium, Phlox, Verbena, Sweet pea, Zinnia, Columbine, Coral bells, Daylilies, Hosta, Lily-of-the-valley, Shasta daisy, Sedum, Yucca.

Fall Tonic: In Late September or early October make a solution of:

2 cups Epsom salts 2 cups liquid soap

3 tablespoons baking powder

1 cup tobacco juice

Fill balance of quart jar with water

Use a hose-end lawn sprayer of 15-20 gallon capacity to spray the tonic over 1,500 square feet.
